### ***Who are we and What do we do?***

The Pan Cheshire Child Death Overview Panel (CDOP) is part of a national organisation reviewing all deaths of children aged from 0 to 18 years, sharing lessons learned to prevent future deaths. Pan Cheshire was formed in 2013, the Partners are Cheshire East, Cheshire West & Chester, Halton Borough and Warrington Borough Councils. The panel has representation from all four Local Safeguarding Children Boards in Cheshire, Health, the Police, Social care and Education

### ***PAN CHESHIRE CDOP LEARNING EVENT—28th April 2017***

The panel delivered a learning event for front line professionals to increase their knowledge and understanding of the CDOP process. The panel discussed “what is the responsibility of the professionals who have been involved in the management or care of a child that dies” how reporting and improved paperwork from professionals can assist panel members in the decision making process.

The overwhelming response from the professionals who attended was that it was an informative event, the attendees praised the speakers and stated that they enjoyed the case study



The CDOP panel invited a number of bereavement charities to set up stalls at the event providing information for the professionals. The event was supported by Ampharo, Child Bereavement UK, Safety Central – Cheshire Interactive life skills centre, Alder Centre, Harry & Co, Lullaby Trust, with literature provided by CAPT, SAND and NHSBT
